**Subject: Delegation of Financial Powers to the Regional Authorities of Directorate General of Foreign Trade.**

In supersession of all earlier O&M Instructions issued by the Directorate General of Foreign Trade on the above subject (including the OM 1/2019 dated 20/02/2019), the revised delegation of financial powers for implementation of various provisions of Foreign Trade Policy and Handbook of Procedure 2015-20 (updated as on 5<sup>th</sup> December, 2017) at the respective levels in the Regional Authorities and Zonal Offices will be as under, with immediate effect and until further orders:-

### NOTE

1. For the sake of convenience, the delegated powers have been prescribed in the same order of Paragraphs/Chapters as appearing in Foreign Trade Policy/Hand Book of Procedures.
2. Notwithstanding anything contained herein before, the aforesaid powers will be exercised at various levels within the framework of the Foreign Trade Policy/Hand Book of Procedures in force from time to time.
3. No Regional Authority is empowered to further delegate the powers to any of the subordinate authorities.
4. In the offices of Jt. DGFT, head by Dy. DGFT, Dy. DGFT would be empowered to exercise powers vested in Jt. DGFT. Similarly in the offices of Dy. DGFT, headed by Asstt. DGFT, Asstt. DGFT would be empowered to exercise powers vested in Dy. DGFT. In the offices of Addl. DGFT where no Joint DGFT is posted, Dy. DGFT would exercise powers of Joint DGFT to the extent delegated by Addl. DGFT. In the offices of Addl. DGFT, headed by Joint DGFT, Jt. DGFT would exercise powers of Addl. DGFT.
5. In the offices headed by Addl. DGFT, Addl. DGFT would be empowered to exercise all delegated powers.
6. Powers delegated to any subordinate authorities can be exercised by the higher authority.
7. If any provision of Policy/ Procedures for which the delegation of powers remains unprescribed, the powers will vest in DGFT.
8. Authorizations will ordinarily be signed and issued by FTDO/Asstt. DGFT, but in their absence, the authorizations shall be signed and issued by officers above them.
9. Only one Deficiency Letter (DL) may be issued conveying all the deficiency in the application in one go which may be decided at the level of FTDO/ Asstt. DGFT. Second or subsequent DL can be issued only with the approval of



Dy. DGFT or Jt. DGFT/Addl. DGFT, as the cases may be. Licenses will be issued after approval of the officer (Dy. DGFT/Jt. DGFT/Addl. DGFT) at whose level second or subsequent DL was issued.

10 The powers have been delegated for the purpose of issuing sanctions/ licenses/authorizations as per the entitlement of the applicants. If any application is required to be rejected for good and sufficient reasons, it should be done, as per the delegated powers, only with the approval of the next higher authority in each office.

11. All licenses/authorizations will be subjected to review mechanism under which Dy. DGFTs shall review 5% of the total cases decided by Asstt. DGFT and FTDO on random basis. Jt. DGFT shall review 1% of the total cases under their charge of the Divisions/Sections. Head of the Office will be responsible for overall working of the office and will periodically test check the cases.

12. Asstt. DGFTs/FTDOs are empowered to issue GSP certificates .

13. In case of Development Commissioners of SEZs who are authorized to issue various types of licenses/Permissions/Certificates under the Foreign Trade Policy, the powers of Jt. DGFT/Dy. DGFT and Asstt. DGFT/FTDO would be delegated to the Joint Development Commissioner & Dy. Development Commissioner respectively.
